“Shaping out lives around the supremacy of Christ”

Colossians 1:15-23

1. “All things” are to be reconciled to Jesus because “all things” are fallen (Col 1:20); this includes mankind, the material world, and the spiritual world. What are the implications for us as believers as we live and work, if Christ wants every area of life to be redeemed?
2. We are to embrace the supremacy of Christ in our own lives by making Jesus our absolute; however there can often be a tension between our other priorities and Christ. Discuss some of the challenges in living in such a way, that other things do not replace Christ as the most important thing in our lives?
3. We work for Christ’s supremacy by building the church to display His glory to our city. Discuss some of the ways in which we can help build ChristChurch London?
4. We can also work for Christ’s supremacy by being involved in, and reaching out to society. We need men and women who love Jesus, working to redeem every area of life knowing that every area is to come under Christ’s Lordship. How as lifegroups can we encourage each other to engage with the different areas of society that we are involved with, in order to bring about more of the supremacy of Christ?
