**Living a life that glorifies God**

**Isaiah 62:1-5**

1. Isaiah was a man who was motivated by his love for God and His people. What are the different motivations we have, and why is love for God such an effective motivator? How does this impact our approach to serving in church?
2. Isaiah is longing for the righteousness of God's people to "shine out like the dawn, her salvation like a blazing torch" (Is 62:1). What are the things we can do to ensure we are motivated by a longing for God's glory?
3. It's God's plan to bless the nations through the church, "The nations will see your righteousness, and all kings your glory" (Is 62:2). How does this expectation provide us with faith to plan for a great future, faith to reach out across the city and faith to aim for the nations?
4. "I will not stay silent" (Is 62:1), is a declaration by Isaiah to take action and to do something. How can we too 'not stay silent' and take action to glorify God? How can we also do this by helping to serve in ChristChurch London?
