Read 1 Peter 2: 4-10

1. What do you think of the fact that if God chose us to be his people, we can't "un-choose" ourselves? What does it mean to be a chosen people?
2. Being a royal priesthood means that we can have a privileged experience of God as a Christian. How does this knowledge affect the way you pray? What can we do to avoid being cynical about God speaking to us through dreams, impressions, or prophetic words?
3. We are also a holy nation. How importantly do we prize holiness? What is the difference between living under law & living under grace?
4. What are the consequences for us of "belonging to God"? What can we do to put God first in every aspect of our lives?
5. We are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, and a people belonging to God. Which of these has the most affect on you individually, and what can we do to live out our identity in Christ better?
