Making room for the prophetic

2 Kings 8: 1-6 (David also made reference to the Shunammite woman's building a room for the prophet Elisha, having the miraculous provision of a Son, and having the son miraculously healed after he had died – all of which are mentioned in 2 Kings 4)

1. David talked a lot about many of the miracles & prophetic insight that he has seen during his life & ministry. What did you, as a Life Group, think of his many stories about the miraculous & the prophetic? How did it make you feel? (Maybe excited, envious, cynical, hopeful?)
2. Why do you think we don't see much of the miraculous in our daily life in London?
3. David talked about the sacrifices that the Shunammite woman was prepared to make to see a miracle: She built a room for the prophet Elisha, mucked her own routine up, and invested time & energy to house Elisha. What sacrifices do you think we may have to make to see miracles happen?
4. God gave the Shunammite woman prophetic direction through the warning about the famine. Do you have any experiences where God has clearly guided you? Is there anything we can do to hear God more clearly or grow in the prophetic?
5. The Shunammite woman miraculously had all her possessions restored after the famine. How does this encourage us?
6. Is there anything we can do to see the miraculous & prophetic at work in ChristChurch Life Groups?
