

ChristChurch London Life Group Discussion Outline – 21/09/08
“What sort of church will we become?” – Dave Stroud

Read Matt 5:13-16

1. “You are the salt of the earth” (v13). How does this truth impact the way we live our lives and what are some of the challenges of being “Salt” in our generation?
2. “You are the light of the world” (v14). The single most powerful way of being the light of the world ourselves is leading those that don’t know Jesus to him. Ask members of your group to share some of the ways in which they are reaching out, helping lead those you work, study or live life with to Jesus?

Discuss with your group how this affects the way you invite people to Alpha. (Alpha launches: Mon 29th Sep: Jane Rosier; Wed 1st Oct: Mr Justice Mark Hedley)

3. To be salt & light is to be involved in the broader shaping of culture. We need men and women who love Jesus, working to redeem every area of society with a determination to influence our culture. Ask members of the group who are involved in shaping culture to share something of what they are doing; and then discuss how as a lifegroup you can encourage & support them in this.
4. Jesus description of us being “salt & light” was not only to our city but also for this nation and the nations of the world. How can we grow in our passion for the nations and our commitment to work out our faith in the local church at the same time?
