**“The attractiveness of Jesus” – Adrian Holloway**

*As you pass round the bread and wine, please look at the verses below, one by one. You may wish to look some of them up in context and discuss what Jesus' words mean to you today. (Adrian added some questions below to prompt you if you get stuck.)*

**“If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him.” (John 7:37-38)**

Q. What did Jesus mean by this remark?

Q. Is this your own experience?

**“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.” (Matthew 11:28-30)**

Q. What is a “yoke” anyway?

Q. Have you found Jesus' burden “light”?

**“What does it profit a man if he gains the whole world, yet loses his soul?” (Mark 8:36)**

**“The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field. Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant looking for fine pearls. When he found one of great value, he went away and sold everything he had and bought it.” (Matthew 13:44-46)**

Q. How would you describe the “treasure” or the “pearl” to someone who was not a Christian?
